

Professional Licensing Disclosures

Federal regulations require Washtenaw Community College to publicly disclose, for each educational program designed to meet the educational requirements for a specific professional license or certification required for employment in an occupation (or advertised as meeting those requirements), information about whether program completion would meet those requirements in another state. These public disclosure requirements apply to programs regardless of their modality (on campus, online, and/or hybrid).
